The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the FOIA documents from US Fish & Wildlife Service. Those attending were Commissioners Cameron Edwards, David Hubert and Cody Younkin and Jim Carlson with Stillwater Technical Solutions. Chairman Younkin called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Jim Carlson presented the Board with the Freedom of Information Act document received on February 11, 2022 from US Fish and Wildlife (FWS). Some discussion was held regarding the file that was incomplete but there were signed Black Footed Ferret (BFF) reintroduction plan and assigned monitoring plan. Carlson reviewed the letter and suggested that BOCC should consider a moratorium for accessing lands that may be considered part of the Smoky Hill Safe Harbor Agreement (SHA). Discussion was held and it was moved and seconded by Commissioner Edwards and Hubert to send moratorium on accessing lands that may be part of the Smoky Hill SHA consistent to the Logan County Black-Tailed Prairie Dog Health, Safety and Management Plan.
