

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met on Monday, February 7, 2022. Those present were Commissioners David Hubert and Cody Younkin. Commissioner Cameron Edwards was absent. The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Chairman Cody Younkin.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

Jim Carlson with Stillwater Technical Solutions phoned the board to discuss prairie dog control. The Board agreed to continue the effort of trying to control prairie dogs as defined in the Logan County Black-Tailed Prairie Dog Health, Safety and Management Plan. Discussion was also held regarding the county's response to EPA regarding the use of Rozol.

Noxious Weed/Prairie Dog Director Denny Mackley met with the Board to discuss treating prairie dogs and give an updated on how much he has treated so far. Mackley also requested signatures on his Annual Report with Kansas Department of Ag and the Noxious Weed Management Plan. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin to sign both reports. Motion carried 2-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin respectively to approve the 2021 Annual Reports for Paxton, Oakley, McAllaster and Logansport Townships. Motion carried unanimously.

The minutes from January 18, 2022 meeting were reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

The minutes from January 20 & 28, 2022 special meetings were reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

The Board reviewed the 9 hours of overtime for the Health Department and 20 hours for the Road Department in January.

The Board reviewed the January 31, 2022 Payroll Register as follows: General \$42,803.47; County Health \$10,638.65; Road & Bridge \$18,793.12; Noxious Weed \$4,156.03; Fire \$461.10 and EMS \$12,949.14 for a total of \$89,801.51. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin respectively to approve the Payroll Register as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated January 31, 2022 as follows: General \$37,461.39; County Health \$6,009.25; Road & Bridge \$46,588.37; Noxious Weed \$6,385.18; Multi County Health \$37.03; Fire \$1,136.32; EMS \$2,283.53; Drug Forfeiture \$5,590.60; County Bond & Interest \$10,540.00 and Payroll Clearing \$854.73 for a total of \$116,886.40. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin respectively to sign the Annual Agreement for Services with Developmental Services of Northwest Kansas, giving them a \$28,000.00 appropriation for the year 2022. Motion carried 2-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin to sign the Utility Request and Petition from SMJ International, LLC to add 6 ft MW dish with mount and coax to existing cell tower at 270' at 1602 K-25 Highway, Russell Springs. Motion carried 2-0.

There being no further business discussed it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin respectively to adjourn the meeting at 10:35 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, February 22, 2022 at 8:30 a.m.
