

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met for a special meeting by phone on Wednesday, March 3, 2021. The purpose of the special meeting was to review and consider the letter received by landowners Calvin and Jay Haverfield dated March 1, 2021 regarding poisoning Prairie Dogs on their property. Those present by phone were Commissioners Cameron Edwards, David Hubert and Cody Younkin, County Attorney Craig Urich and Jim Carlson with Stillwater Technical Solutions. Chairman Younkin called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

After reviewing the letter from landowners Calvin and Jay Haverfield and the information available from US Fish and Wildlife Services, the Board determined that there was no Safe Harbor Agreement on the property the County plans to treat. Therefore, it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Hubert to do their due diligence to control Prairie Dogs per Kansas Statutes and proceed with treating prairie dogs. Motion carried 3-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Hubert respectively to adjourn the meeting at 8:55 a.m. Motion carried.
