

The Oakley City Council met in special session on April 19, 2021, in the meeting room at the Oakley City Office, 415 W. 2nd Street, and streamed live at <https://www.facebook.com/discoveroakley/live> at 7:00 P.M., for the object and purpose of conducting a hearing for the Performance Evaluation of Grant Agreement Number 20-CV-01. Council President Leasa Huddle presided.

Council members present. Leasa Huddle, Russ Kahle and Eli Winger; Ilene Nickel, Kile Zerr and Mayor Shane Stephenson were absent.

City staff present. City Administrator Bradley Pendergast and City Clerk Leann Hughes.

Others present. Corina Cox with Northwest Kansas Planning and Development Commission was present by phone.

Call to order. Council President Huddle called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

NEW DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:

Hearing – Performance Evaluation of Grant Agreement Number 20-CV-101. Council President Huddle opened the public hearing. Cox explained the grant project and the dollars awarded and asked if there were any public or Council questions; there were none.
