

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met on Monday, May 3, 2021. Those present were Commissioners Cody Younkin and Cameron Edwards. Commissioner David Hubert was absent. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Cody Younkin.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

Landfill Operator Craig Edwards met with the Board to discuss the dumping of grain bags into the pit at the Landfill. It was the consensus of the Board to research the matter.

Register of Deeds Joyce Bosserman met with the Board to discuss issues she's having with the Courthouse copier. Bosserman asked the Board if they would like to keep putting money into our current machine since it has no maintenance agreement or go ahead and purchase a new copier. Bosserman presented a quote from Office Works for a Ricoh IM C3000 copier for \$6,512.00 with the trade in of our current copier. It was the consensus of the Board to discuss at the next meeting.

Victor Kumar with Sleep Inn met with the Board asking for help with his second half of 2020 property taxes. Kumar stated Covid-19 caused the hotel a loss of revenue and he needs help with his taxes. The Board told Kumar their hands are tied and there is not much they can do but agreed to pass his information on to the Appraiser's Office to review his information.

The minutes from the April 26, 2021 meeting was reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to sign the Notice and Waiver to help support Western Kansas Child Advocacy Center. Motion carried 2-0.

The Board reviewed the 3.25 hours of overtime for the Health Department and 53 hours for the Road Department for April.

The Board reviewed the April 30, 2021 Payroll Register as follows: General \$44,409.64; County Health \$15,438.39; Road & Bridge \$24,353.98; Noxious Weed \$3,823.17; Fire \$459.81 and EMS \$9,494.30 for a total of \$97,979.29. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin

respectively to approve the Payroll Register as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated April 30, 2021 as follows: General \$51,865.75; County Health \$4,860.45; Road & Bridge \$7,993.68; Noxious Weed \$1,429.61; Multi County Health \$10.81; Fire \$3,800.92; Employee Benefits \$1,000.00; EMS \$1,596.69; Drug Forfeiture \$1,250.00; Special Drug & Alcohol \$500.00 and Payroll Clearing \$2,431.05 for a total of \$76,738.96. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin respectively to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

The Board reviewed the invoice for \$5,000.00 for the JD Z530M mower for the Weed Department. The quote that was approved for \$4,862.94 at the last meeting was for a 45 inch deck. Mackley wanted a 54 inch deck therefore it was moved and seconded by Commissioner Edwards and Younkin to approve the invoice for \$5,000.00 for the 54 inch deck. Motion carried 2-0.

There being no further business discussed it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin respectively to adjourn the meeting at 10:35 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 17, 2021 at 8:30 a.m.
