

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met on Monday, July 3, 2023. Those present were Commissioners David Hubert, Cameron Edwards and Cody Younkin. The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Chairman David Hubert.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Edwards to approve the agenda with the addition of Greg Jirak at 8:30 a.m. Motion carried 3-0.

Newly appointed Sheriff Greg Jirak met with the Board to introduce himself as he took office on June 19, 2023.

Health Administrator Angie Kahle met with the Board to discuss grant possibilities. Discussion was also held regarding employees of the County that are not up to date on Tetanus and Hepatitis A & B. Several employees are volunteers to help if a disaster was to occur and could be exposed to many hazards that these vaccines could protect. It was the consensus of the Board to draft a letter to employees to suggest getting up to date.

County Attorney Craig Uhrich met with the Board to discuss the meeting he had with the railroad regarding the litigation in Page City. Discussion was then held regarding his budget request for 2024. Uhrich also informed the Board he has the paperwork filed regarding the last tax sale and that should be finished up and approved by the Judge this week on motion day.

The minutes from the June 19, 2023 meeting were reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Edwards to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the 3.5 hours of overtime for the Health Department, 57 hours of overtime for the Road Department, 1 hour for the Weed Department and 80.5 hours for the EMS Department in June.

The Board reviewed the June 30, 2023 Payroll Register as follows: General \$51,596.46; County Health \$14,799.57; Road & Bridge \$21,716.00; Noxious Weed \$4,937.94; Fire \$7,304.00 and EMS \$18,277.51 for a total of \$118,631.48. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin respectively to approve the Payroll Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the additional June 30, 2023 Payroll Register as follows: SLFRF \$191,627.15 for a total of \$191,627.15. It was moved and seconded

by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin respectively to approve the Payroll Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated June 30, 2023 as follows: General \$141,940.33; County Health \$13,020.81; Road & Bridge \$1,846.92; Noxious Weed \$67.61; Fire \$12.59; EMS \$2,919.24; Equipment Reserve \$95,000.00; Co Attorney Drug Forfeiture \$203.68 and Payroll Clearing \$5,597.87 for a total of \$260,609.05. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to sign the yearly Sand Agreements with Joe Radnor, Kevin Plummer, Rose Survivors Trust and Rose Family Trust as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

There being no further business discussed it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin respectively to adjourn the meeting at 10:15 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 17, 2023 at 8:30 a.m.
