

The Oakley City Council met in special session on July 9, 2021, in the meeting room at the Oakley City Office, 415 W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, at 7:00 P.M., for the object and purpose of discussing the 2022 Preliminary Budget and an Executive Session for Non-Elected Personnel. Mayor Shane Stephenson presided.

City staff present. City Administrator Brock Sloan and City Clerk Leann Hughes.

Others present. Bradley Pendergast, via Zoom.

Call to order. Mayor Stephenson called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

#### NEW DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:

2022 Preliminary Budget Discussion. Bradley Pendergast provided some revised budget information to City Administrator Brock Sloan, who had a copy at the meeting for the Council. Pendergast noted that numbers for the Police Department were revised to include the COPS grant and to add in a shift differential, which can be implemented if needed.

Russ Kahle joined the meeting by phone at approximately 7:06 P.M.

Discussion followed. Pendergast also noted the draft pay plan has been integrated into the preliminary budget and there was discussion of the need to review dispatch agreements.

Executive Session for Non-Elected Personnel. An executive session was not needed.
