

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met on Monday, August 21, 2023. Those present were Commissioners David Hubert, Cameron Edwards and Cody Younkin. The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Chairman David Hubert.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Julie Yarmer with Freedom Claims Management, Inc. met with the Board to give an update on the 2023 healthcare coverage for County employees.

Sheriff Greg Jirak met with the Board to discuss helping the Police Department out since they are short staffed. Jirak said he was approached by the Chief and has offered two of his deputies to work on their days off. Jirak said he is anticipating this to be short term and asked the Board if they are agreeable with them using the county vehicles and equipment and get reimbursed mileage from the City. It was the consensus of the Board to allow the request if insurance approved.

The Board phoned Attorney Chris McGowne to discuss severed mineral taxing.

The minutes from the August 7, 2023 meeting were reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated August 10, 2023 as follows: General \$17,997.84; County Health \$8,228.37; Road & Bridge \$31,007.65; Noxious Weed \$10,841.99; Fire \$3,472.27; Prairie Dog \$18,400.00; EMS \$4,517.45; County Attorney Drug Forfeiture \$785.00 and Payroll Clearing \$2,000.32 for a total of \$97,250.89. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

There being no further business discussed it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin respectively to adjourn the meeting at 10:25 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 5, 2023.
