

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met on Monday, October 2, 2023 at the Russell Springs Road Shop. Those present were Commissioners David Hubert, Cameron Edwards and Cody Younkin. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m. by Chairman David Hubert.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board met with the Road Department employees to get an update on their department.

Road Department Supervisor Nate Hales met with the Board to give an update on his department. Discussion was also held regarding putting the 2009 Chevy and the 2015 Chevy pickups up for bid. It was the consensus of the Board to put them up for bids with the submission deadline of November 3, 2023.

The Board discussed the retirement of Craig Edwards with the Road Department and Landfill. Edwards told the Board he is retiring October 31, 2023. It was the consensus of the Board to start advertising for the Landfill position.

The Board reviewed bids received for bulk propane for the 2023-2024 season. The quotes were from Bosselman Energy for \$1.55/gallon; Dinkel Gas Company for \$1.50/gallon and Shaw Motor Co., Inc. for \$1.52/gallon. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to accept the bid from Dinkel Gas for \$1.50/gallon for 8,500 gallons of propane. Motion carried 3-0.

The minutes from the September 18, 2023 meeting were reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the 6 hours of overtime for the Sheriff's Office; 1.5 hours of overtime for the Road Department and 150.5 hours for the EMS Department in September.

The Board reviewed the September 29, 2023 Payroll Register as follows: General \$54,166.27; County Health \$14,330.51; Road & Bridge \$24,855.27; Noxious Weed \$3,697.15; Fire \$7,876.64 and EMS \$18,667.21 for a total of \$123,593.05. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and

Younkin respectively to approve the Payroll Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated September 21, 2023 as follows: Special Equipment Road \$34,789.00 for a total of \$34,789.00. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated September 25, 2023 as follows: Special Equipment Road \$39,789.00 for a total of \$39,789.00. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated September 29, 2023 as follows: General \$22,123.28; County Health \$7,573.40; Road & Bridge \$61,164.86; Noxious Weed \$14,505.45; EMS \$1,774.73; Equipment Reserve Fund \$6,669.10; Drug Forfeiture \$5,000.00; County Attorney Drug Forfeiture \$382.69 and Payroll Clearing \$1,878.24 for a total of \$121,071.75. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin to purchase a 2019 Ford F150 for \$34,789.00 and a 2022 GMC Canyon for \$39,789.00 from Herl Chevrolet for the Road Department. Motion carried 3-0.

There being no further business discussed it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Younkin respectively to adjourn the meeting at 10:10 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 16, 2023.
